Discussion/Action Items

- The meeting minutes from April 28, 2026, were approved, subject to an amendment requested by Liv Haselback to incorporate the terminology “crossings may flood” for water crossing signs.
- Robb Starr moved, and Ellen Buchanan seconded, to accept the minutes of March 18 and April 28, 2026, as amended.
- The motion was approved unanimously.

Discussion/Action Items

Items covered included:

- Chapters 1, 2A, and 2B are compiled and under internal review.
- Recommended standards revised, especially for roadways and floodplain preservation.
- “Property acquisition” goal retitled to “floodplain preservation.”
- Goals revised for conservation easements, nature-based practices, and floodplain preservation.
- Discussion on definitions and implementation of “open space” and “nature-based solutions.”

- New goals tabled for further review pending nature-based solutions manual.
- Task 4C: Studies in Hardin and Polk Counties; field data collected for drainage improvements.
- Polk County master drainage plan update: three problem areas identified (Corrigan, Pleasant Hill, Indian Springs).
- Leveraging prior studies and models for further analysis.
- Reviewed and compared recommendations from cycle one and other regions.
- Discussion on expanding county regulatory authority, operation and maintenance funding, and use of BLE data for floodplain management.
- Emphasis on prevention, public education, and cross-agency integration (TXDOT and TWDB).
- Additional recommendations may be addressed during future meetings.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 6: Consider and act upon approving Floodplain Management Practice recommendations.

Discussion/Action Items

- The group discussed and acted on approving amended floodplain management goals and practices.
- The group acknowledged that amendments may be made later based on future discussions and new information, but the current revisions were approved during the meeting.
- Robb Starr moved, and Ellen Buchanan seconded, to accept the minutes of March 18 and April 28, 2026, as presented.
- The motion was approved unanimously.

AGENDA ITEM NO. 7: Consider and act upon approving the amended floodplain management goals for inclusion in the 2028 Neches Regional Flood Plan.

Discussion/Action Items

- **Floodplain Preservation:**
The previous “property acquisition” practice was retitled and revised to “floodplain preservation.”
- **Conservation Easements:**
Revised Goal:
Add conservation easements as a specific goal, with updated language to clarify short-term (10 years) and long-term (30 years) planning horizons.
Rationale: Supports land conservation and nature-based flood mitigation.
- **Nature-Based Practices:**
The group discussed and approved language to encourage nature-based practices, conservation easements, and floodplain preservation in all projects. The language was clarified to allow “and/or” (not requiring all three in every project).

“Must consider in all projects and should incorporate nature-based practices such as conservation easements or floodplain preservation.
